



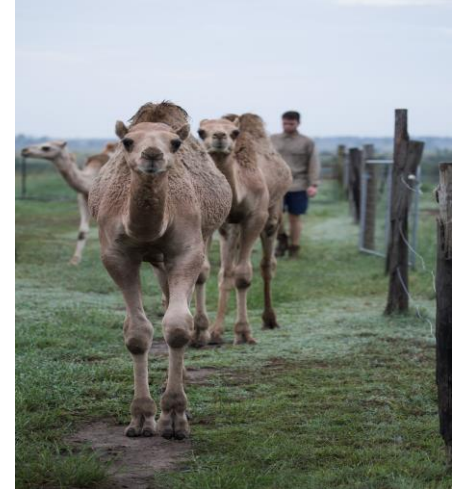

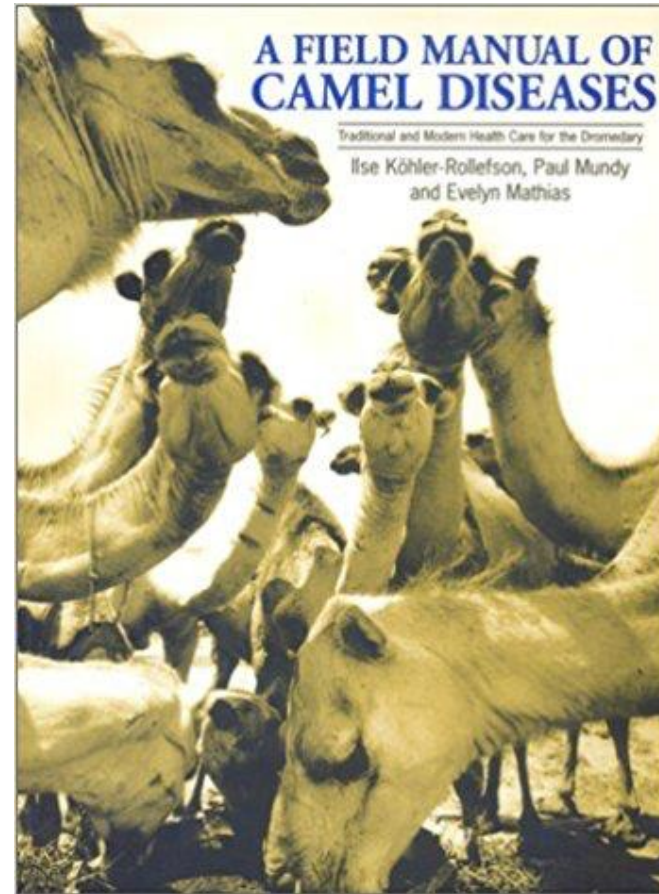
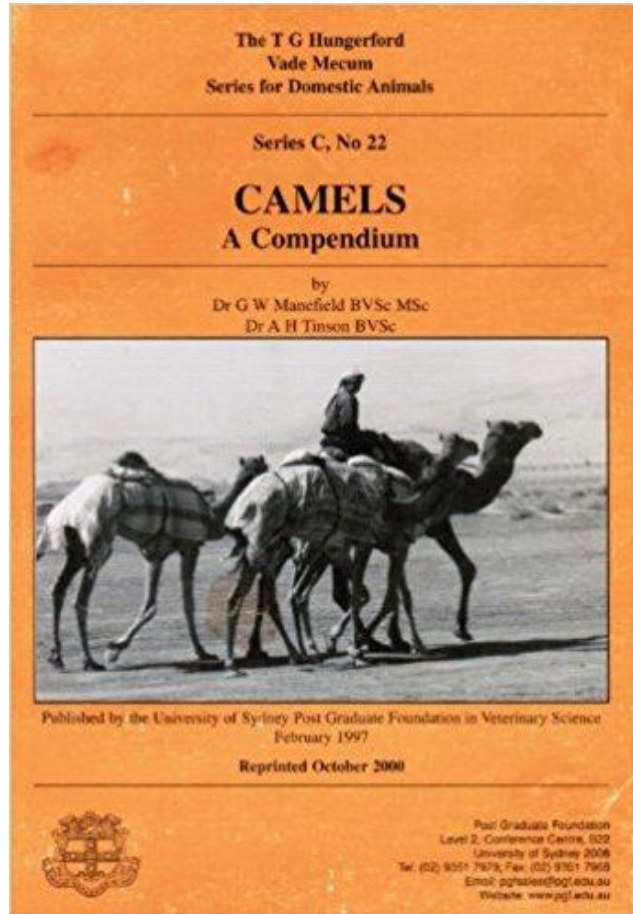

Camel Conditioning

- Feeding up
- Understanding a change in environment
- Parasites and parasite control
